Skip count along the path by twos to get help the squirrel get to the acorns!

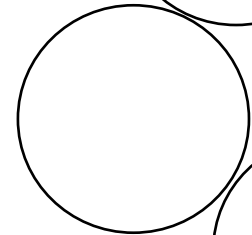

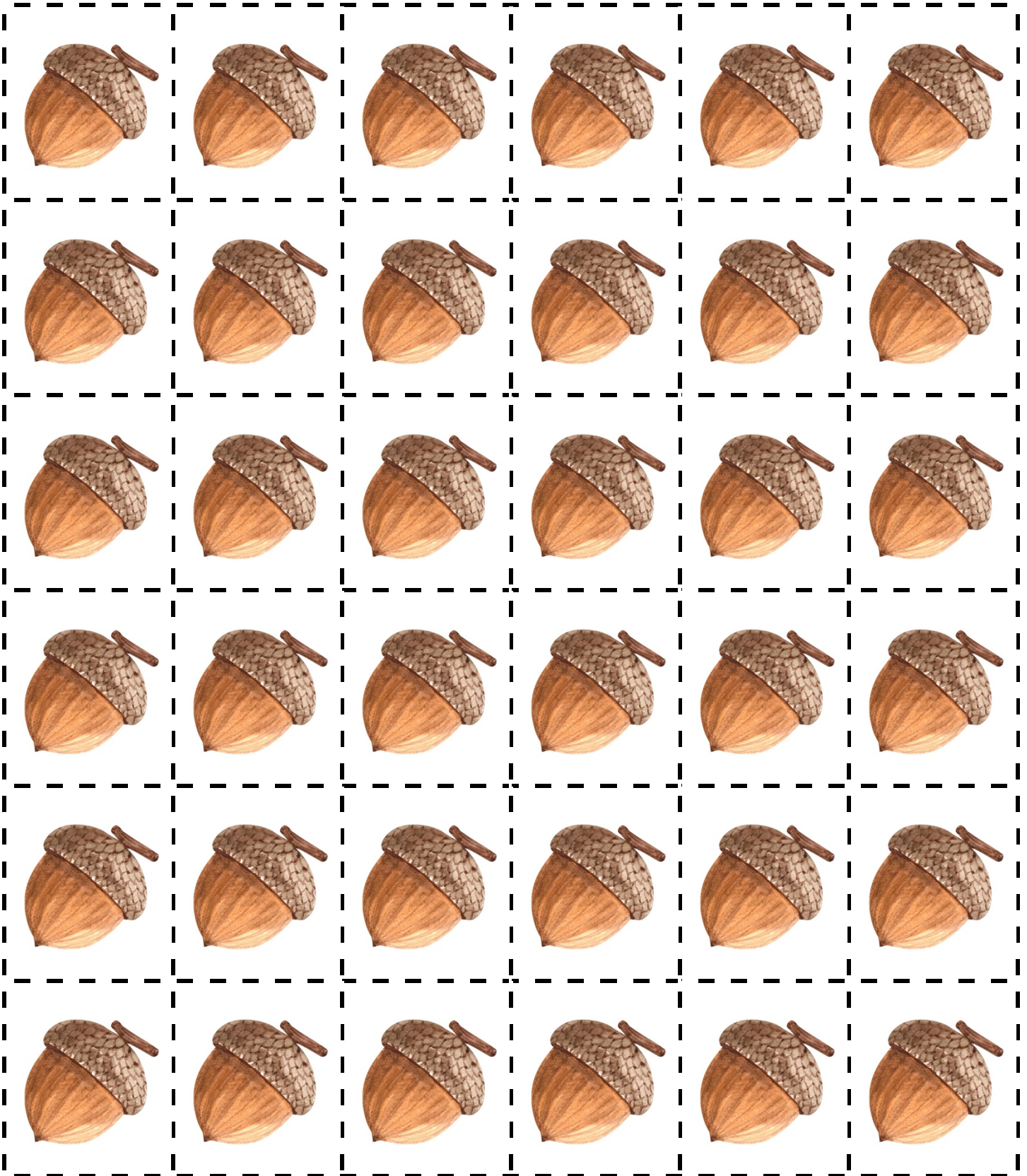
Counting Cup or Pages
